Help Needed. Volunteer Opportunities

The Center needs help in many different areas. This provides you, our members, a chance to be more involved in ways that can make a big difference in the future of The Center. Following are some of the needs and opportunities:

*Newsletter. We could really use someone with desktop publishing skills (Publisher or interest in learning how to use Publisher) to help with preparation and set up of the monthly gazette for printing. Feature articles about various activities, members of The Center or future programs and events could be written for the gazette. If you like to write, your skills can be useful in this committee or with the publicity committee.

*Publicity. We need a committee to explore and facilitate various ways of publishing many of The Center's events, programs and activities. Limited participation can be a result of lack of knowledge. We need people to develop and distribute flyers as well as explore other means of publicizing our events and special programs.

*Hidden Treasures sales. We would like to expand the hours that Hidden Treasures is open for sales. Our goal is to be open a few hours on Saturday mornings or one evening a week. It would seem that the income should increase if we can be open some hours when potential customers are working. We need a sufficient number of volunteers to insure that only a 2-3 hour shift a month would be requested. We also require at least two people working during each shift. No pricing or display creating is required.

*Membership recruitment and involvement. We need to aggressively recruit new members as well as be more proactive in getting both current and new members involved in the activities and offerings of The Center. Do you enjoy meeting new people? If so, this is a committee that can benefit from your help and involvement.

If you would like to become more involved at The Center in one of the above activities, please call one of us or Mindy Anderson. If you would like be more involved but are not sure how your skills can be helpful, please call one of us. We'd be happy to visit with you and help you find your niche. We can use the assistance of many people in a variety of other ways in addition to those listed above.
